Glenn County is updating the Housing Element of the General Plan to address the State's requirements for the 2021-2029 planning period and wants your input!

What is a Housing Element?

The Housing Element is a required element of the County's General Plan and serves as a blueprint for meeting the housing needs of our residents, at all economic levels, and addressing special housing needs. The Housing Element focuses on the unincorporated area of the County and includes the following:

- Population, household, and housing profile
- Inventory of sites suitable to accommodate the County's housing needs
- Assessment of financial and programmatic resources for housing
- Analysis of fair housing issues
- Analysis of constraints to housing production
- Goals, policies, and actions to address housing needs
